I was the primary organizer for the 2001 and 2002 Summer Institutes (“Understanding High-Risk Sexual Behavior” and “Interventions for High-Risk Sexual Behavior”). From 2000-2003, I taught a Practicum in Sex Therapy, a one-year intensive practicum for doctoral students in clinical psychology and counseling, and was the course coordinator for the Sexual Science Research Seminar. I was co-chair of the Interdepartmental Graduate Committee on Human Sexuality, which, together with the Kinsey Institute, organizes the Ph.D. Minor in Human Sexuality offered at Indiana University. I also responded to queries about graduate education related to human sexuality from students and health professionals from around the world.
